

Project main activities -Expected output/results

I. **Capacity-building** accompanying actions implemented in three countries, focused on strengthening the knowledge, skills, and institutional capacities of partners and relevant stakeholders to effectively address health and safety challenges in the agricultural sector. These actions support cooperation, exchange of best practices, and improved implementation of preventive measures at territorial and organizational levels.

II. **Joint guidelines document** prepared - involved the development of a comprehensive document aimed at preventing health and safety risks in the agricultural sector. One joint framework document was produced, complemented by country-specific contributions prepared by each partner. The process included territorial analyses of the existing situation, the definition of a shared methodology for developing and applying the guidelines, and the implementation of one territorial survey to test and validate the proposed measures. Partners also committed to actively promoting, applying, and further developing health and safety prevention measures within the agricultural sector beyond the project duration.

III. **Dissemination seminars organized in three countries** - to present the developed guidelines, share results of the territorial analyses and surveys, and raise awareness among stakeholders. These seminars facilitated knowledge transfer, encouraged stakeholder engagement, and supported the adoption of improved health and safety practices in agriculture at local and regional levels
